


Handout # 14	Advanced Driving Tips
Previous Experience	Full License holder looking to develop skills in hazard awareness using 'The system of car control'
The SYSTEM of Car control IPSGA	<p>This system of driving is taken from 'Roadcraft', and is used by the Police and other professional drivers. It will ensure the driver is completely aware of all hazards and plan effectively, ensuring the vehicle is always in the correct position, at the correct speed and in the correct gear. It requires concentration and a good level of discipline to achieve.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • INFORMATION to Give and Receive information • POSITION to see and be seen • SPEED must be able to stop in distance seen to be clear • GEAR correct gear to match road speed • ACCELERATION to give car stability 
COMMENTARY DRIVING	<p>Use of COMMENTARY driving to improve AWARENESS / ANTICIPATION skills</p> <p>Raise visual horizon – eyes on 'main beam', identify next limit point</p> <p>Structure your commentary. Use the 'snap shot view' and work back towards you</p> <p><i>"eyes at limit point, road will dip and bend to the left, can anticipate more pedestrians, ped X ahead on green, people waiting, planning to stop. Car behind following close, enforcing a rear protecting system"</i></p> <p>Nothing ever happens suddenly, the clues are all there to see, if we know where to look!</p>
CORNERING	<p>Position position 1 or 3 to see and be seen</p> <p>Speed match speed with Limit Point</p> <p>Gear If the limit point is moving towards you – slow down select correct gear to match speed before bend to maximise response and stability on exit</p>
